**ALL freshmen, sophomores and juniors** will attend school through Tuesday, June 19th; however they will have a 2-hour early release that day and get out of school at 1:50 pm. Our teachers will clean out their classrooms and finish their grades on Wednesday, June 20th which is now a grading/prep day.

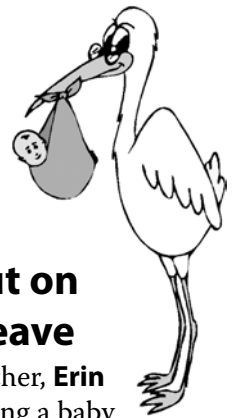

### Change in our Fall Registration Process

In an effort to utilize our resources more efficiently, **we will not be mailing our registration packets home the first week of August like we have done in previous years.** Instead, our parent volunteers will be stationed at (4) tables located in the forum handing them out from 8:00-3:00 on Wednesday, August 8th, Thursday, August 9th and Friday, August 10th.

The registration packets will have multiple items tucked inside of them and have your child's name/grad year on the outside of them which will make them easy to locate when you and/or your child stop by to pick them up. ### PROM

A conflict forced us to change the date of this year’s PROM from Saturday, May 19th to **Saturday, May 12th** instead.

The Prom will be held @ the Flinn Block Hall on 1st Street in Albany from 8:00-11:00 pm. Tickets will be \$20.00 per person and will go on sale in the forum two weeks prior to the event. Attendance and interest in the CHS prom has been declining over the last few years. In order to generate interest, increase attendance, and raise money for next year’s graduating class, this year we decided on a new venue. Finding a new location has been the priority of the last four prom committees, but try as we might, there is not another location either big enough or willing to take us in Corvallis. Located on 1st Street in Albany right over the bridge, Flinn Block Hall is a beautiful space and a 10-mile drive from CHS. This year’s juniors are thrilled to offer a new prom experience to the seniors. To accommodate this beautiful spot, it was necessary for us to change the date. Months ago, the juniors talked to the administration, consulted the school calendar, and checked with sports, theater and the various interests about potential conflicts. When none were found, we booked the date. As always, there will be both administrative and adult supervision. We also have police on hand outside the building, as we do every year, to ensure the safety of our students. Although we apologize for any inconveniences, we have created what we hope will be a memorable prom.

p.s. There are four to five free city lots within a few block radius and free parking in all of downtown Albany.

Several changes will go into effect next year in response to concerns raised this school year about the new bell schedule implemented in September.

Among the changes are:

- An earlier, consistent start time – Classes will begin every morning at 8 a.m., instead of the current start time of 8:15 a.m. or 9:15 a.m. on Wednesday.
- No late start day – Teachers’ PLC time has been rescheduled. They will meet for an hour after school on Mondays, rather than Wednesday mornings.
- An earlier end time – Next year, school will end at 3:05 p.m. on Mondays/Wednesdays, at 2:25 p.m. Tuesdays/Thursdays, and at 2:35 p.m. on Friday.

Lunch is earlier, plus two breaks – The daily lunch break will be from 11:15 to 11:55 a.m. which is nearly an hour earlier than scheduled now. Plus, there is a 15-minute break scheduled mid-morning between the first two class periods and a 10-minute break occurs between the last two periods of the day.

AO time has been extended, but takes place less often – Students will have two 50-minute Academic Options periods during the week on Tuesday/Thursday. On Tuesday, the first 25 minutes will be dedicated to advisor activities, required for graduation. Students will still receive 75 minutes of AO per week. All students will be assigned to and must attend the AO period.

Seven-period schedule – All students will be assigned to seven classes, plus their AO period. The schedule will no longer offer eight periods.

## Oregon Women's Vote Anniversary Celebrated at Gala

This year marks the 100th anniversary of Oregon women getting the right to vote. Corvallis will be celebrating that historic event with drama, history, and dessert on May 16, 7:00 p.m. at the 99-year-old Majestic Theatre, 115 SW Second St. in downtown Corvallis. The event is free and open to the public.

"Oregon Women Vote: A Centennial Celebration" promises a lively evening headlined by actress/ historian James Alan's entertaining presentation, "Soldiers in Petticoats: The Struggles of the Suffragettes," about the national suffrage movement. She'll be followed by JoAnne Trow, President of the Benton County Historical Society and Museum, describing the Oregon suffrage story. Local poet, playwright, teacher, and actress Shelley Moon will conclude the show with a dramatic performance of Sojourner Truth's "Ain't I a Woman?"

Corvallis Mayor Julie Manning will be the evening's Mistress of Ceremonies. Following the performances, attendees are invited to enjoy light refreshments in the lobby. They will also have an opportunity to contribute to a "Gratitude Wall" honoring inspiring women leaders who have influenced their own lives.

"Oregon Women Vote" honors the pioneering success of Oregon women's efforts, as well as National Historic Preservation Month. Historical photographs illustrating women in Benton County history will be on display, and the County Elections Office will staff a voter registration table. This history-focused event is being brought to the public through the efforts of over 20 organizations, businesses, individuals, and local governments, including 509J School District.

## Off Campus Dances and Raves



We want to take a moment to clarify some issues related to dances, raves and other events that occur off-campus. Historically, there have been some school affiliated clubs and organizations that have held such events at off-campus locations like the Oddfellows Hall or the Benton County Fairgrounds.

Recently, the Corvallis School District has instructed administrators to no longer allow clubs/teams to host such off-campus events. While we have worked diligently to create an atmosphere at school dances that is wholesome and free from harassment, we cannot guarantee the same for these events that take place outside the supervision of the district.

These events are typically advertised through social media and the school does not even know that they are occurring. If your child chooses to attend one of these dances or raves, please know that there will be no district supervision and that you are responsible for the safety of your student. There have been reports of alcohol and drug use, highly sexualized dancing, and other behavior that is inconsistent with the mission of the school district.

**The only school sponsored off-campus dance scheduled at this time is the Prom.**

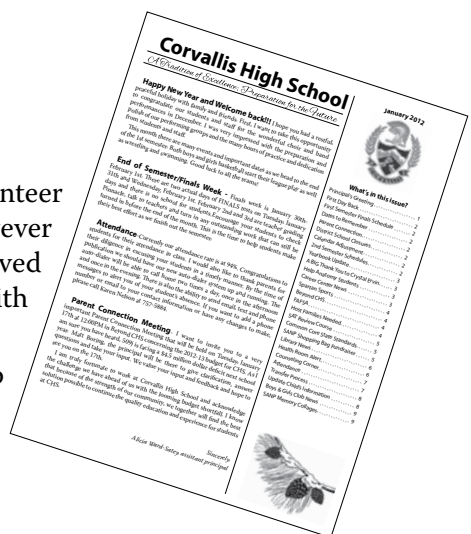

### Getting Cleared for High School Sports

It is not too soon to begin preparing for next year's fall sports season. Conditioning week begins on Monday, August 13th (optional) and official practice/tryouts will begin on Monday, August 20th. To start practice/tryouts on August 20th, you must first be cleared for sports in the Athletic Office during the period between Wednesday, August 15th and Friday, August 17th from 2-5:30pm each day. Each athlete must bring the following:

- Read and sign the code of conduct (with parents); includes academic requirements, training rules and citizenship expectations.
- Have a sports physical if a freshman or junior (also, sophomores and seniors if no physical is on file from the previous year). If you have a physical from 8th grade Track, please bring a copy with you... your next physical would be your sophomore year.
- Everyone must complete a health history information form yearly.
- Complete the travel permission form.
- Pay an athletic user fee: \$150/per sport; (3rd sport each year \$100-excluding Ski, Lacrosse, Equestrian, Cheerleading & Dance).
- Carry medical insurance and purchase a student body card at school registration.

Clearance forms are located outside the CHS Athletic Office. Also, we will offer Sports Physicals between 2:00-5:30pm Wednesday, August 15th (only). Cost will be \$30.00.
